

SUPPLEMENTAL SNAP PRODUCER AGREEMENT

Meter Fee

In accordance with SNAP Producer Agreement, Section 6, Meter Reading Fee, the Utility may charge an annual fee to cover the cost of reading SNAP meters. Any such fee shall be established in writing prior to the execution of the agreement.

The following annual meter reading fee will be charged: \$ _____ 0 _____ (enter "0" if there will be no fee). *This meter fee will deducted from the Producer's annual SNAP production payment. If the SNAP payment due the Producer is not sufficient to cover the meter reading fee, the Producer will be invoiced for the balance due. A Producer who fails to meet this payment obligation will not be allowed to participate in the SNAP program until the Producer pays the amount due along with any accrued late payment fees.*

Section 5, Payments by the Utility, Paragraph 2, of the SNAP Producer Agreement stipulates that if an annual SNAP meter reading shows more kilowatt-hours than is anticipated by this agreement, the Producer must provide the utility with documentation to substantiate the feasibility of the additional kWh production before any applicable SNAP payments will be made. If the additional kilowatt production cannot be substantiated to the Utility's satisfaction, it will be assumed that the additional kilowatts were generated from some other source, and no SNAP payments will be made for the additional kilowatts. Under such circumstances, the Utility may elect to terminate this SNAP Producer Agreement in accordance with Section 9, Default of the SNAP Producer Agreement.
