The following information refers to the Methow Transmission Project Public Scoping Notice mailed to you the week of November 12, 2003.

**Correction:**

The fourth sentence on the front page of the notice under Project Purpose and Need stated: "Pateros, Twisp, and the unincorporated lower Methow Valley area are currently served by a single transmission route constructed in 1948 that crosses Loup Loup Pass from Okanogan to Twisp." This statement is inaccurate in that Pateros is not served by the Loup Loup Transmission Line.

**Clarification:**

On the color map enclosed in the Public Scoping Notice, the substation identified at the southern intersection of the proposed Twisp Pateros transmission line and the existing transmission line would not be a full substation and would not allow for distribution of electricity. It would likely be a switch that may or may not be fenced. The exact nature of this facility will be determined through project analysis and identified in the Draft EIS.
