Listed cherry trees are non-fruit bearing. Listed pear tree does have fruit, but it does not create an impact upon agriculture.

Customers that live at higher elevations, should check hardiness for their location before they buy.

Other trees, not listed, may be planted if species and location approved by ROW Superintendent.
