Loree,

Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County filed a final license application for the Enloe Hydroelectric Project on August 21, 2008. The District is currently responding to a FERC request for additional information on whether the proposed project is consistent with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program. FERC has asked the District to consult with Ecology in developing a response to item No. 22 in the attached letter. The District's response to the FERC request will be filed with FERC in early 2009.

We understand from our consultant (ENTRIX, Inc.) that you have requested additional information about the project to assist you in determining the relationship between the Washington CZMP and the Enloe Project. The information you have requested is presented below:

1. Copy of FERC Additional Information Request (AIR) Item 22

#### Coastal Zone Management Act

22. Under the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, the Commission cannot issue a license for the Enloe Project until Ecology either concurs with the Okanogan PUD that the proposed project would be consistent with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (Washington CMP) or waives the requirements by not acting on its request for concurrence within 180 days of receipt. Upon review of the record for your proposed project, we are unable to determine if you certified that your proposed project would be consistent with the Washington CMP and submitted a

request to Ecology for its concurrence. Therefore, please certify that your proposed project would be consistent with the Washington CMP and submit your consistency certification to Ecology along with a request for their concurrence. Please provide us with a copy of your consistency certification and request for concurrence along with documentation showing the date that Ecology received your request.

3. Status of project-related permit applications

Applications for required Federal, State and Local permits have not yet been prepared. Permit applications will be prepared and submitted to appropriate agencies in the 2009 to 2010 timeframe to allow sufficient time for approval before construction begins in Summer 2011.

That 30-day review will begin when the AIR responses are circulated by the PUD, tentatively scheduled for this Friday.
